

Middle School Assessment

Students applying for enrollment in the Middle school are assessed for their instructional levels in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

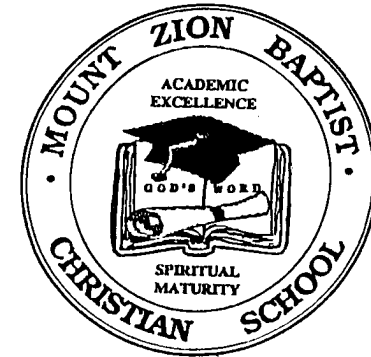
The assessment time requires two to two and half (2½) hours.

Criteria for Admission into the Middle School

1. Student completes the Reading, Writing and Math assessments and demonstrates an instructional level that is at least grade level.
2. Student has a satisfactory conduct history in his or her previous school and in the community.
3. Student receives favorable recommendations from the previous school or teachers.
4. Student is willing to put forth good effort to learn and cooperate.
5. Parents or Guardians agree:
 - a. to cooperate with the basic teachings of the Bible and our Christian faith.
 - b. to pray with their child and regularly attend a Bible teaching church.
 - c. to make timely tuition payments.
 - d. to work in partnership with your child's teacher to help support his or her growth and to cooperate with the school's policies.

After the assessment has been completed, a conference will be scheduled to share the assessment results, and discuss school information.
